
MARKHAM-THORNHILL

CHERISH INTEGRATED SERVICES

Cherish Integrated Services has been a pillar in Markham, supporting persons with developmental disabilities for over 10 years. Recently they received \$550,000 (over \$400,000 from the Government of Canada) in funding to upgrade their Denison Street Community Centre. The renovated Centre is now much more accessible for clients, and is also intended to be used as a community gathering space, to host events and programs that are open to the public. Projects like this benefit our whole community, and this funding will ensure that Cherish can continue their great work for years to come!



CANADA'S CHILD CARE PLAN

WHAT IT MEANS FOR **YOU** AND YOUR **FAMILY**

- \$10-a-day child care in the next four years, cut fees by 25% starting immediately, and deliver 50% fee reductions by the end of this year which will save Ontario families \$6,000 per child on average.
- Create 86,000 new child care spaces in the province, and ensure that all families in Ontario have access to affordable, high-quality and inclusive child care.
